

StepUP Programme Evaluation August 2012 – July 2013








Project Summary

The first year for StepUP has been very challenging. Both external factors such as the increased requirement for online job applications, as well as varying skills and needs of our clients have impacted the StepUP programme greatly. However, we were able to adapt to these factors due to our holistic support service which provides education, volunteering, debt advice, counselling and employability support. Our StepUP programme has brought together our range of services to provide participants with a programme of learning, volunteering and employability support. Participants have taken part in literacy and IT classes, vocational training, accredited courses and completed a volunteer work placement. Working in partnership with the National Careers Service and Job Centre Plus participants also receive careers advice, CV support and help searching and applying for jobs. Over the past 12 months we have had a lot of success delivering this programme, all participants have either completed the programme, been signposted to appropriate education or training, continued with support at St Vincent's or moved in to employment. The following report provides a breakdown of who has taken part and their outcome, an update on each area of the project over the past year as well as update on the individual circumstances of each client.


We have found that this project was not a one size fits all and through the funding provided by Jimbo's Fund, we have been able to provide provision through our volunteer and education department that meets different needs. The journey to employment can require a different path depending upon the individual client and we have provided this in the form of work experience, learning and direct employability support. Some of our participants have needed to take part in all three areas, while others have needed specific support from a combination. At times, improving CVs and offering sound careers advice has been enough, other participants have required hands on experience through volunteering to boost their CV and confidence, while others have taken part in accredited learning or improved their reading, writing and IT skills. All of this support leads to one destination; employment. Participants have found work as teaching assistants, factory workers, cleaners, social care assistants, ESOL tutors, translators, security guards, shop assistants, restaurant assistants and community workers. Some participants are working through the programme whilst others have moved on to further education and training at college or with community providers.


Post Codes for StepUP participants




Gender of participants

Project Update – Year 1

Allocate and recruit appropriate resources to set up the StepUP programme.	 Filing system created. Online database set up. Application form, reference form agreed. StepUP agreement created. Other developments supporting employability skills through Step UP funding:

- 16 ESOL classes, 3 IT classes and 5 employability courses have been set up involving over 300 students
- An additional 45 volunteers have been supported and recognised for their achievements.
- Work club has seen over 200 people for careers advice, CV support, job search and careers advice.

On-going developments:

- Develop peer mentor system and possibly recruit dedicated employment paid or volunteer advisors with AIG training through NCS.
- Improve system of enrolling participants on Step Up requires more admin support (specific tasks to be set and agreed).
- Promote programme more in local area and recruit focus on target area of LS9, LS14 and LS15.
- Develop interactive work placement mapping though area.
- Develop work placements with other providers and private sector.
- Develop partnerships with employers and further routes into employment.
- Health and safety and safeguarding support to be reviewed.
